Higher temperatures and sunnier days mean one thing: yard work. If you've got access to a patch of grass or a garden that needs some post-winter help, equip yourself to make the hard work simpler.

**Mow a lawn** as big as  $\frac{1}{3}$  of an acre on just one charge with Black & Decker's 36-volt 19-inch rechargeable mower. The battery can be removed for more convenient charging. \$399.99; find a retailer at [www.blackanddecker.com](http://www.blackanddecker.com).



**Lug around** your garden gear with a Gorilla 2-in-1 utility cart, which can turn into a flatbed and carries up to 800 pounds. \$64.99 at Sears.
