Warmer temperatures and sunnier days mean one thing: yard work. If you've got access to a patch of grass or a garden that needs some post-winter help, equip yourself to make the hard work simpler. ■



▲ **Rechargeable.** Mow a lawn as big as one-third of an acre on just one charge with Black & Decker's 36-volt 19-inch rechargeable mower. The battery can be removed for more convenient charging. \$399.99; find a retailer at [blackanddecker.com](http://blackanddecker.com).



◀ **Grow grass.** Tough yards need a tough seed: Scotts Turf Builder EZ Seed, which contains a protective growing material that lets new grass sprout almost anywhere. Available in Sun and Shade, Tall Fescue and Bermuda grass. \$14.44 for 3.75 pounds at Home Depot.
