These Lube Sprays Will Blow You Away



Some [Liquid Wrench](#) people stopped by our office recently. Do you know what really impressed us, besides their innovative new products? Their technicians answer the phone.

Talk about having an ear to the ground — and being responsive to customers! The tech people hear all sorts of creative ways customers use the company's now six products that lubricate, penetrate and protect.

Example 1: We used the new [Dry Lubricant](#) (sprays on wet but lubricates with no oily residue) on a sticky drawer slider. But how else we could use this product specifically in winter?

- Before removing snow from our roof, lubricate extension ladders and hinges of folding ladders
- Lubricate control cables on snow blowers so they don't freeze or stick in cold weather
- Apply on sled runners, for a smoother, faster glide

Example 2, using [Silicone Spray](#) in winter:

- Spray snow blower chutes and snow shovels to stop snow from sticking
 - Spray outdoor statues and garden figures to slow water penetration and freezing that can cause cracking during winter
- Wipe down grill covers to make snow removal easier
 - Makes snow-sledding discs more slippery
